INTRO

Tell people the assembly is about choices. The choices we make will make a difference. There is nothing you will do that does not affect someone somewhere. So let's take a look more closely.

Get 3 volunteers up to the front. These 3 are asked to hold hands and twist themselves up into a complex position that is basically impossible to get out of. Then get them to untangle themselves but say that only one of them is allowed to move at any one time. As the exercise continues, you can stop that person moving and ask someone else to.
